What organizations could we partner with?

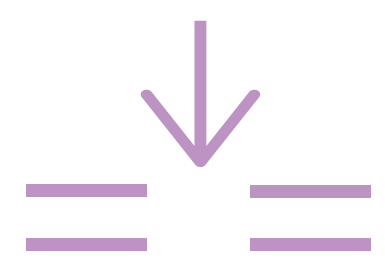


Plan and view of the new Green Gateway plaza at Mission and Valencia intersection.

By narrowing Valencia Street at this location, currently overly-wide, the new project will increase pedestrian safety by shortening the pedestrian crossing and will improve the experience of waiting for the bus by providing new seating.
